- Establish measurable objectives and targets to ensure continuous improvement aimed at eliminating work-related injury and illness.
- Establish robust processes to monitor and review health and safety performance.
- Provision of resources needed for the establishment & implementation of a Health & Safety Management system with clear structure and assignment of authorities.
- Establish effective consultation and communication channels that ensure involvement of employees in the decision-making process that could potentially impact on health and safety, and effective distribution of information to all employees and stakeholders.
- Develop and implement effective risk management systems and processes to proactively identify hazards and eliminate or reduce risks.
- Promote a culture of working safely in which all incidents are reported and learnings from incidents are communicated.
